

Bradley J Oostindie, MA, is the Founder and Clinical Director of Ready To Focus Neurofeedback. As a 1994 graduate of the Wheaton College Graduate School Clinical Psychology program, he has been in practice as a Master's level psychologist in the State of Michigan for nearly 25 years. In 2005 he trained at the ADD Centre in Toronto with Dr. Linda Thompson, one of the leaders in the neurofeedback field. Since that time he has specialized in the field of neurofeedback and biofeedback, working with thousands of neurofeedback clients and developing programs to administer the treatment in academic, office, and home-based settings.

Previous work includes serving as a staff psychologist at DeVos Children's Hospital in Grand Rapids, Michigan where duties included neuropsychological testing and assessment as well as behavioral counseling interventions with children. During that time, his work on neuropsychological deficits in children with cystic fibrosis was presented at the CF national conference and subsequently published in the Journal of Pediatric Pulmonology. He has also provided services in both inpatient and outpatient psychological practice settings serving children, adolescents, and adults.

His work in the field of neurofeedback has been recognized by local media several times in the West Michigan area.

At this time, Bradley Oostindie oversees neurofeedback programming at Ready To Focus in both the office and home-based settings. Additionally, he provides training to other therapists who desire to use neurofeedback as a treatment intervention. He regularly speaks at conferences on the topic of neurofeedback and other issues related to childhood behavioral issues and education. He is currently completing a doctoral degree in clinical psychology, specializing and focusing in the research of brain-based treatments.
